


Hossam Shabat

Correspondent for Al Jazeera, who was killed by Israel in a targeted assassination on March 24, 2025.

FALSE ALLEGATIONS

Israel put **Hossam Shabat** on a **kill list** with five other journalists, based on groundless accusations that international agencies called a **“smear campaign.”**

He was **hunted down and killed** by an **Israeli drone** while reporting in north Gaza.

“By God, I fulfilled my duty as a journalist. I risked everything to report the truth”

Ismail al-Ghoul and Rami al-Rifi


Worked together for Al Jazeera when an Israeli drone targeted and killed them in their clearly marked press vehicle on July 31, 2024.

HIDING CRIMES

Rami al-Rifi began working with **Ismail al-Ghoul** after Israel's invasion forced most journalists to flee Gaza City, cutting off **access to evidence** of its **war crimes** in the northern Gaza Strip.

DENYING PROTECTION

Mohammed Abu Hattab's colleague Salman Al Bashir, a correspondent for Palestine TV, found out about his death live on air. He **tore off his press vest and helmet**, declaring through tears:

“These are just slogans that we are wearing. They don't protect any journalist at all. These shields don't protect us. We are victims, directly on live television. We are losing souls, one by one, with complete impunity”



Shireen Abu Akleh

Killed by the Israeli military with a single shot below her ear while she was covering an Israeli invasion of the Jenin refugee camp in the West Bank on May 11, 2022.

ZERO ACCOUNTABILITY

44 journalists

killed by Israel before Oct. 7 2023
(2000-2022)

In all that time, no one was held accountable for killing a journalist.

Israel continues to kill with impunity.
